<u>Water Testing:</u> Water tests are good. Jorgensen is still waiting for the EPA requirements for 2024. <u>Usage:</u> December 2023 water usage was 1.01 million gallons. The current average flowrate is 23 GPM. <u>Maintenance Log:</u> The 2024 schedule for maintenance of equipment has been set. There have been 2 water turn-offs.

**SCADA:** SCADA has been connected to the generator. It can now be remotely started. Alarms have been set to go off when the mixer stops running.

**Phase III Update:** Wilson Bros. has ordered the important parts for Phase III that are taking the longest to be delivered.

Pay Requests: Glenn and Richard signed the paperwork.
